NOTES FOR PASCHALTIDE

- Throughout Paschaltide (through None of the Saturday after Pentecost), at all Offices, “Alleluia” is added to all Antiphons when they are said entire, and to all *Ps.* and *R.*. But “Alleluia” is not added to the *Ps.* in the Preces at Prime and Compline when they are said, nor to “Right dear” &c. at the end of Prime.
- “Alleluia, alleluia” is added to the Short *R.* at Vespers and Lauds, as noted in their places.
- At Vespers and Lauds, the Commemoration of the Holy Cross is said in place of the Suffrage of All Saints.
- At Prime, the Chapter “Now unto the King” is always said, even on Ferias.
- The Antiphon of the BVM, *Regina caeli* (“O Queen of Heaven”) is said until None of the Saturday in the Octave of Pentecost.
- There is no kneeling in the Office during Paschaltide.

Sunday, April 26

LOW SUNDAY (*Dominica in Albis*) AND OCTAVE OF EASTER [*Greater Double, I Class*]
Commem. Ss. Cletus & Marcellinus, Pp. Mm.

AT LAUDS – Festal Pss. of Sunday, with Ants. from Proper / Chapter, “Dearly beloved: Whatsoever is born” / Short *R.*, Hymn, & *Ps.* from Paschaltide Ferial Office / Ben. Ant. “The same day at evening” (as at Saturday Vespers) / Greg. Collect, “Grant, we beseech thee”; or Tik. Collect “Almighty Father” / Commem. Cletus & Marcellinus (Ant. “Daughters of Jerusalem”, *Ps.* “Right dear” & Collect as below) / “Let us bless the Lord” without “alleluia, alleluia”

Collect of Ss. Cletus & Marcellinus – May the precious confession of the blessed Martyrs and Bishops, Cletus and Marcellinus, be our solace, O Lord, and may their loving intercession ever be our sure defence. Through, &c.

AT PRIME – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Sunday, with Ant. from Proper / Chapter, “Now unto the King” / No Preces / In Capitular Office (out of choir), Short Lesson “If ye then be risen”

AT THE LITTLE HOURS – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Sunday, with Ant. from Proper / Chapters and *Ps.* from Proper / Collect as at Lauds

AT VESPERS (1st Vespers of St George) – Pss. from I Vespers in Common of Apostles (out of Paschaltide) [7*], with Ants. from Common of Apostles in Paschaltide [17*] / Short *R.*, “Light perpetual” from Common [16*] / Hymn, “Of all thy warrior Saints” from Common of Martyrs in Paschaltide [31*] / *Ps.* “O ye holy” [17*] / Mag. Ant. “Light perpetual” [17*] / Collect of Feast, “O God, who makest us” from Proper [512] / Commem. Sunday (Ant. “After eight days”, *Ps.* “Abide with us” & Collect as at Lauds) / No Suffrage

AT COMPLINE – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / No Preces

Monday, April 27

SAINT GEORGE, MARTYR (*Archdiocese Patron*) (*Transferred*) [*Double I Class, Com. Oct.*]

AT LAUDS – Festal Pss. of Sunday, with Ants. from Common of Apostles in Paschaltide [17*-18*] / Chapter & Short *R.* from same Common / Hymn, “Thou followest, Martyr of thy God” [32*-33*] / *Ps.* “Right dear” [19*] / Ben. Ant. “Daughters of Jerusalem” [19*] / Collect of Feast, “O God, who makest us” from Proper [512] / No Commem.

AT MASS – Red / *Protexisti* (Common of Martyrs in Paschaltide) / Gl. / Proper CSP / No Cr. / Easter Pref.

AT PRIME – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Monday, with Ps. Ant. 1 “Thy Saints, O Lord” from Lauds / Chapter, “Now unto the King” / No Preces / In Capitular Office (out of choir), Short Lesson “We know that all things” from None

AT THE LITTLE HOURS – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Monday, with Ps. Ant. 2, 3 or 5 / Chapter & *℟̄* from Common / Collect as at Lauds

AT VESPERS (2nd Vespers of St George) – Pss. from II Vespers of Common of Apostles, with Ants. as at Lauds (omitting 4th) / Chapter, “Then shall the righteous man” as at Lauds / Short *℟̄*, “Light perpetual” [16*] / Hymn, “Of all thy warrior Saints, O Lord” [31*] / *℣*. “Right dear” [20*] / Mag. Ant. “O ye holy and righteous” / Collect as at Lauds / Commem. Mark (Ant. “Daughters of Jerusalem” as at Lauds, *℣*. “O ye holy” as at I Vespers & Collect from Proper) / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT COMPLINE – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / No Preces

Tuesday, April 28

SAINT MARK, EVANGELIST (*Transferred*) [*Double II Class*]

Commem. Of the Octave of St George

AT LAUDS – Festal Pss. of Sunday, with Ants. from Common of Apostles in Paschaltide [17*-18*] / Chapter, Short *℟̄*, Hymn, & *℣* from same Common / Ben. Ant. “Daughters of Jerusalem” / Greg. Collect of S. Mark, “O God, who didst exalt”; or Tik. Collect “O Almighty God” / Commem. George (Ant. “Light perpetual” & *℣*. “O ye holy” as at I Vespers, Collect from Proper) / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT MASS – Red / *Protexisti* (proper) / Gl. / 2nd CSP George (no 3rd) / No Commem. Rogations / Cr. / Apostles’ Pref.

AT PRIME – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Tuesday, with Ps. Ant. 1 “Thy Saints, O Lord” from Lauds / Chapter, “Now unto the King” / No Preces / In Capitular Office (out of choir), Short Lesson “We know that all things” as at None

AT THE LITTLE HOURS – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. throughout the week, with Ps. Ant. 2, 3 or 5 from Lauds / Chapter & *℣* from Common / Collect as at Lauds

AT VESPERS (2nd Vespers of St Mark) – Pss. from II Vespers of Common of Apostles, with Ants. of Lauds from Common (omitting 4th) / Chapter, “Then shall the righteous man” as at Lauds / Short *℟̄* & Hymn from Common / *℣*. “Right dear” / Mag. Ant. “O ye holy and righteous” / Greg. Collect of S. Mark, “O God, who didst exalt”; or Tik. Collect “O Almighty God” / Commem. George (Ant. “Daughters of Jerusalem” as at Lauds & *℣*. “O ye holy” as at I Vespers as at Lauds, Collect of Feast) / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT COMPLINE – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / No Preces

Wednesday, April 29

AT LAUDS – All as on the Feast, with: / Commem. Holy Cross

AT MASS – As on Feast, except: / 2nd sea. CSP BVM & 3rd sea. CSP for Church or Patriarch

AT PRIME – All as on the Feast, except: / Pss. of Wednesday / Preces are said

AT THE LITTLE HOURS – All as on Feast, except: / Pss. throughout the week

AT VESPERS (1st Vespers of Octave Day) – As on I Vespers of the Feast / No Commem.

AT COMPLINE – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / No Preces

Thursday, April 30

THE OCTAVE DAY OF ST GEORGE [*Greater Double*]

AT LAUDS – All as on the Feast

AT MASS – All as on the Feast

AT PRIME – All as on Feast, except: / Pss. of Thursday

AT THE LITTLE OFFICE – All as on Feast, except: / Pss. throughout the week

AT VESPERS (1st Vespers of Ss. Philip & James) – Pss. from I Vespers in Common of Apostles (out of Paschaltide), with Ants. from Lauds in Proper (omitting 4th) / Short *R̄*, Hymn & *V̄* from Common of Apostles in Paschaltide [16*-17*] / Mag. Ant. “Let not your heart” from Proper / Greg. Collect of Feast, “O God, who makest us” or Tik. Collect “O Almighty God” / Commem. George (Ant. “O ye holy”, *V̄* “Right dear” & Collect from Proper) / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT COMPLINE – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / No Preces

Friday, May 1

SAINTS PHILIP AND JAMES, APOSTLES [*Double II Class*]

AT LAUDS – Festal Pss. of Sunday, with Ants. from Proper / Chapter, Short *R̄*, Hymn & *V̄* from Common of Apostles in Paschaltide / Ben. Ant. “I am the way” from Proper / Greg. Collect of Feast, “O God, who makest us”; or Tik. Collect, “O Almighty God” / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT MASS – Red / *Clamaverunt* (proper) / Gl. / One CSP / Cr. / Apostles’ Pref.

AT PRIME – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Friday, with Ps. Ant. 1 “Lord, shew us the Father” from Lauds / Chapter, “Now unto the King” / No Preces / In Capitular Office (out of choir), Short Lesson “We know that all things” from None in Common

AT THE LITTLE HOURS – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. throughout the week, with Ps. Ant. 2, 3 or 5 from Lauds in Proper / Chapter & *V̄* from Common / Collect as at Lauds

AT VESPERS (2nd Vespers of Ss. Philip & James) – Pss. from II Vespers of Common of Apostles (out of Paschaltide), with Ants. as at Lauds in Proper, omitting the 4th / Chapter, “Then shall the righteous man” as at Lauds in Common / Short *R̄* & Hymn as at I Vespers / *V̄* “Right dear” from Common / Mag. Ant. “If ye abide in me” from Proper / Greg. Collect of Feast, “O God, who makest us”; or Tik. Collect, “O Almighty God” / Commem. Athanasius (Ant. “O Teacher” with “alleluia”, *V̄* “The Lord loved” with “alleluia”, & Collect from Proper) / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT COMPLINE – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / No Preces

Saturday, May 2

AT LAUDS – Pss. of Saturday, with Paschaltide Ants. / Chapter, Short *R̄* (in Paschaltide) Hymn & *V̄* (“alleluia”) from Common of a Confessor Bishop / Ben. Ant. “Well done” (“alleluia”) / Collect from Proper / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT MASS – White / *In medio Ecclesiae* (Common of Doctors) / Gl. / One CSP / Alleluia with Verses / Cr. / Easter Pref.

AT PRIME – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Saturday, under Ps. Ant. 1 “Behold a great priest” (with “alleluia”) from Lauds in Common / Chapter “Now unto the King” / No Preces / In Capitular Office (out of choir), Short Lesson “He consecrated him” from None in Common

AT THE LITTLE HOURS – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. throughout the week, under Ps. Ants. 2, 3 or 5 (with “alleluia”) from Lauds in Common / Chapter & *V̄* (with “alleluia”) from Common / Collect as at Lauds

AT VESPERS (1st of Holy Cross Day) – Pss. of Sunday, with Ants. of Lauds from Proper (omitting 4th) / Chapter “Brethren: Let this mind” as at Lauds / Short *R̄*, Hymn & *V̄* from Proper / Mag. Ant. “O Cross, surpassing” / Collect from Proper / Commem. Sunday (Ant. “I am the Shepherd”, *V̄* “Abide with us” & Greg. Collect “O God, who by the humiliation” or Tik. Collect “Almighty God, who hast given”) / Commem. Athanasius (Ant. “O Teacher” with “alleluia”, *V̄* “The Lord guided” with “alleluia”, & Collect from Proper) / No Commem. Holy Cross

AT COMPLINE – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / No Preces
